At this time, the final date of booking and receipt of the deposit is 1st December 2024, but is open to change. For bookings received after 15th November the full amount payable is required with the booking form. For earlier bookings, the final balance is due on the 19th of November. Bookings will be dealt with in order of receipt.

The bookings for double and single rooms will be closed when the numbers of each are filled. Any bookings received later, will be included on awaiting list. In the event of any cancellations, the two waiting lists will be allocated strictly in order of receipt of the original booking.

All bookings for the event, including hotel accommodation must be made by the event organiser, with the hotel including an extra day before the event or the day after.
